By-Law Title: Recreation By-Law Number: 10

Being a by-law of the Hamlet of Clyde River in the Northwest Territories to assume the responsibility and authority for the provision of Recreation Programs and Services.

WHEREAS Section 184 (G) of the *Municipal Ordinance* provides that Municipal Councils may make bylaws for the acquisition, operation and maintenance of public parks and recreation facilities;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF CLYDE RIVER, at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

This by-law may be cited as the "Recreation By-Law".

INTERPRETATION

2. In this by-law:

a)	"Committee"	means a committee of Council, appointed by and responsible to the Council of the Hamlet of Clyde River;
b)	"Committee of the whole"	means the Council siting informally as a group to discuss matters of mutual interest;
c)	"Council"	means the Council of the Hamlet of Clyde River;
d)	"Hamlet"	means the Hamlet of Clyde River;
e)	"Society"	means a Recreation Society as incorporated under the <i>Societies</i> Ordinance

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 3. a) Council assumes the full responsibility for the provision of recreation programs and services including the construction and maintenance of facilities.
 - b) Council will determine community needs and establish programs, services and facilities to meet these identified needs.
 - c) Council will make known the benefits and values of good recreation programs and encourage community participation.
 - d) Council will deliver recreation programs and operate recreation facilities either directly or through local groups or organizations.
 - e) Council will appoint a Committee whose responsibility will be to carry out Council policy in regard to recreation programs and services.
 - f) Council will ensure that proper records of revenue and expenditures are maintained by their Secretary Manager in the Hamlet books and financial records. These records will be included in the annual year-end audit statements as prepared by the Hamlet Auditors.

g) Council will be responsible for the setting of the annual recreation budget as part of the complete Hamlet budgeting process.

h) Council may, where necessary, make amendments to this by-law by passing an amending by-law in compliance with the *Municipal Ordinance*.
