By-Law Title: Curfew By-Law Number: 27

A by-law of the Hamlet of Clyde River in the Northwest Territories for preventing children from being on the streets and public places after a time fixed by this By-Law and providing for public daily curfew notice and imposition of fines and penalties for breach of such By-Law, pursuant to the provisions of the *Curfew Act*.

WHEREAS the Municipality of Clyde River feels it is necessary to impose a child curfew with fines and penalties for breach of this By-Law;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE HAMLET OF CLYDE RIVER, at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

SHORT TITLE

This by-law may be cited as the "Curfew License By-Law".

INTERPRETATION

- 2. In this by-law:
 - a) "Child" means a person under seventeen (17) years of age with the exception of a youth under the age of seventeen (17) in a common-law relationship;
 - b) "Guardian" means the father, mother or any other person being or entitled to have lawful custody, care or control of a child but does not include another child.

PUBLIC CURFEW NOTICE

3. During the normal school term of the year, public curfew notice shall be given daily, Sunday through Thursday inclusive, at eleven (11:00pm).

REGULATIONS

- 4. The following regulations are in place:
 - a) No child shall be in a public place during curfew unless accompanied by a parent or guardian.
 - b) Every person commits a breach of this By-Law who, being a parent or guardian of a child, permits the child to be in a public place contrary to the provisions of this By-Law.
 - c) Any Hamlet Officer may detain an unaccompanied child, found in a public place during curfew, for questioning and delivery into the custody of a parent/guardian.

PENALTIES

- 5. Every person who contravenes any section of this By-Law is guilty of an offence and such persons, parents or guardian are liable, on a summary conviction:
 - i. for first offence, consultation with parents and/or legal guardian;
 - ii. for second offence, to be given a notice of warning before the Elder's Committee;
 - iii. for third offence, to be brought before a Justice of the Peace;
 - iv. for fourth and consequent offences, a fine of five dollars (\$5.00).
